It is brought to the notice of the General Public that No Objection Certificate or Rent Agreement with the owner is not required, while submitting tender documents for the grant of retailsale foreign liquor (L-2) & retailsale country liquor (L-14A) licences in Union Territory, Chandigarh for the period from 1st May, 2011 to 30th April, 2012, for which tenders have already been invited. Only, the successful allottees of pre-fabricated temporary structure category(s) will have to execute rent deed with or obtain No Objection Certificate from land owning agency/owner, which will be the sole responsibility of the successful allottee. The Department will not be responsible for providing land for pre-fabricated temporary structures. However, the licences will be granted only to those successful tenderers/allottees, who have spaces in their possession and control, where they can start the liquor vend.
